

Abandoned Vehicle Check List

Only WV Towing Companies, WV Repair Facilities, WV Auto Auctions, WV Salvage Yards and WV Dealers can apply for an Abandoned Vehicle. There is no tax charged on abandoned vehicles.

- ☐ DMV-1-TR (Form-1 / Title Application)
- ☐ DMV-130-TR (Application for Possession of a Junked or Abandoned Motor Vehicle)
- ☐ DMV-1B (V.I.N. Verification)
- ☐ DMV-100-TR (Request for Vehicle Information, must already be processed by the Record Dept.)
- ☐ TM-1 (Odometer Certification) (If Applicable)
- ☐ Original Signature Cards from the Certified Mailings to the Owner and Lien Holder (Address provided from records must be the address used for certified mail). If no previous owner found, then must have proof of newspaper ad (Certified Class 1 legal advertisement)
- ☐ Copy of record from either WV's Record Department or previous state's Record Department
- ☐ Copy of letter that was sent to the lien holder or previous owner.
- ☐ Title Fee
- ☐ Registration Fee (If Applicable)

Antique Abandoned Vehicle Check List

Individuals and Property Owners Can Apply for an “Abandoned Antique Vehicle” Title for Vehicles Over 25 Years of Age (House Bill 2402). There is no tax charged on antique abandoned vehicles.

- ☐ DMV-1A-TR (Application for Antique Abandoned Vehicle)
- ☐ DMV-1B (V.I.N. Verification or V.I.N. Request)
- ☐ DMV-VRC-1 (Vehicle Removal Certificate)
- ☐ Property Owners Must Show Proof of Residence
- ☐ \$100 Antique Abandoned Vehicle Fee
- ☐ Title Fee
- ☐ Registration Fee (If Applicable)

After acquiring fees and title documents, all Antique Abandoned vehicle applications must be sent to DMV Headquarters T&R in Charleston. A letter will be sent to the last vehicle owner on file allowing 30 days for a reply. If no reply is received, then the application will be processed.
