- Provides a global platform for GIS professionals, students, and enthusiasts to share projects, demonstrate real-world applications, and inspire collaboration.





What's new in ArcGIS Online (October 2025)

ArcGIS Online helps you understand the world around you by using interactive maps to connect people, locations, and data. You get smart, data-driven visualizations and intuitive analysis tools that deliver location intelligence. This intelligence can then be easily shared as a map, story, dashboard, or app with your organization or the world. ArcGIS Online can help you scale the reach of the work done in ArcGIS Pro, and also work alongside an ArcGIS Enterprise deployment.

The October 2025 update includes new capabilities in Map Viewer, Al assistants for Arcade, new labeling options, and other improvements and new capabilities. Highlights of these updates, along with other enhancements and new functionality throughout ArcGIS Online, are provided below.

October 2025 Highlights



Enhanced Map Viewer Editing

- Advanced editing features include splitting and merging map features, enhanced labeling, and gradient symbology for vector layers.

Pop-up and Video Embedding

- Expanded pop-up configurations support filtering attachments and enabling pop-ups on raster tiles, plus embedding hosted video layers.

Al Arcade Assistant

- The beta Al Arcade Assistant allows users to write Arcade expressions using natural language for easier field calculations and smart mapping.

New Content and Apps

 Updates include a photorealistic 3D basemap, expanded Living Atlas datasets, and Instant Apps enhancements like refreshed Attachment Viewer and Gallery app beta.

- Version 11.5 retires legacy apps and promotes modern tools like Experience Builder and Instant Apps for enhanced user experience.

Deep Learning and Living Atlas

- Redesigned Enterprise Manager offers better system health monitoring and flexible permission control for administrators.

Technical Enhancements

 New .war files support Tomcat 10.1.x and Kubernetes deployment improvements enhance scalability and security.

- ArcGIS Topographic Mapping
 - A server extension that consolidates ArcGIS Production Mapping and ArcGIS Defense Mapping
- Cloud deployment object storage
 - Admins can store the server directories; and alternative to storing in a file share
- Service interceptors
 - An extensibility pattern for developers to inspect and modify existing GIS service requests and responses at runtime
- Notebook templates
 - A collection of ready to use notebooks
- Audit logs
 - Now supported for access operations on map, feature, geoprocessing, and image services






Cartographic and Field Usability Enhancements





What are tasks?
