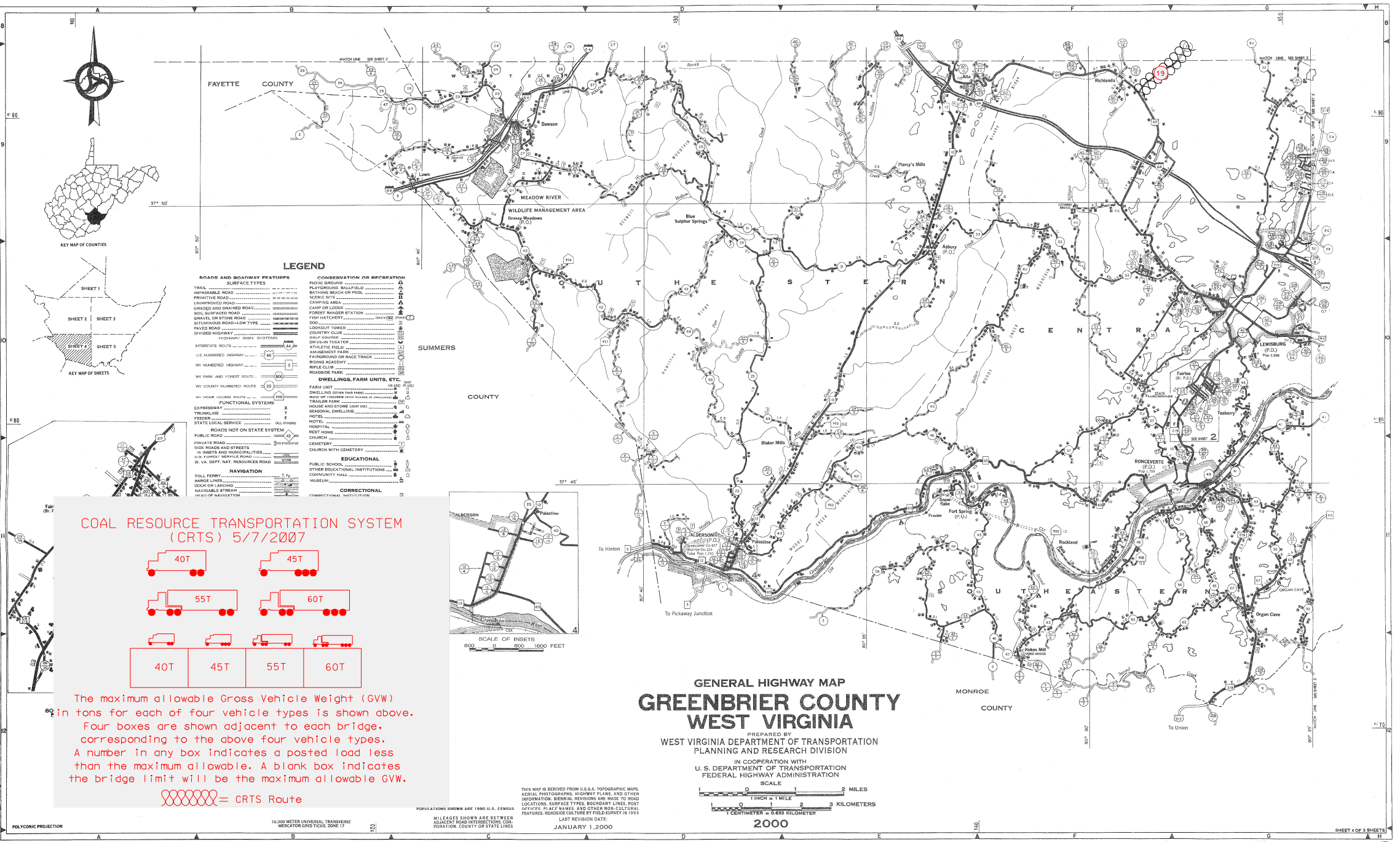
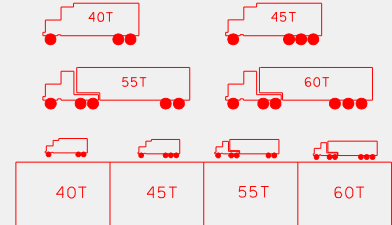




COAL RESOURCE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (CRTS) 5/7/2007



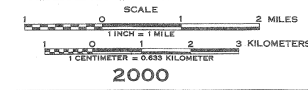
