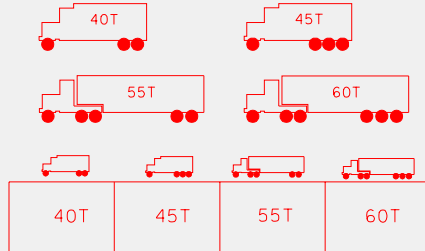


# COAL RESOURCE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (CRTS) 5/11/2009

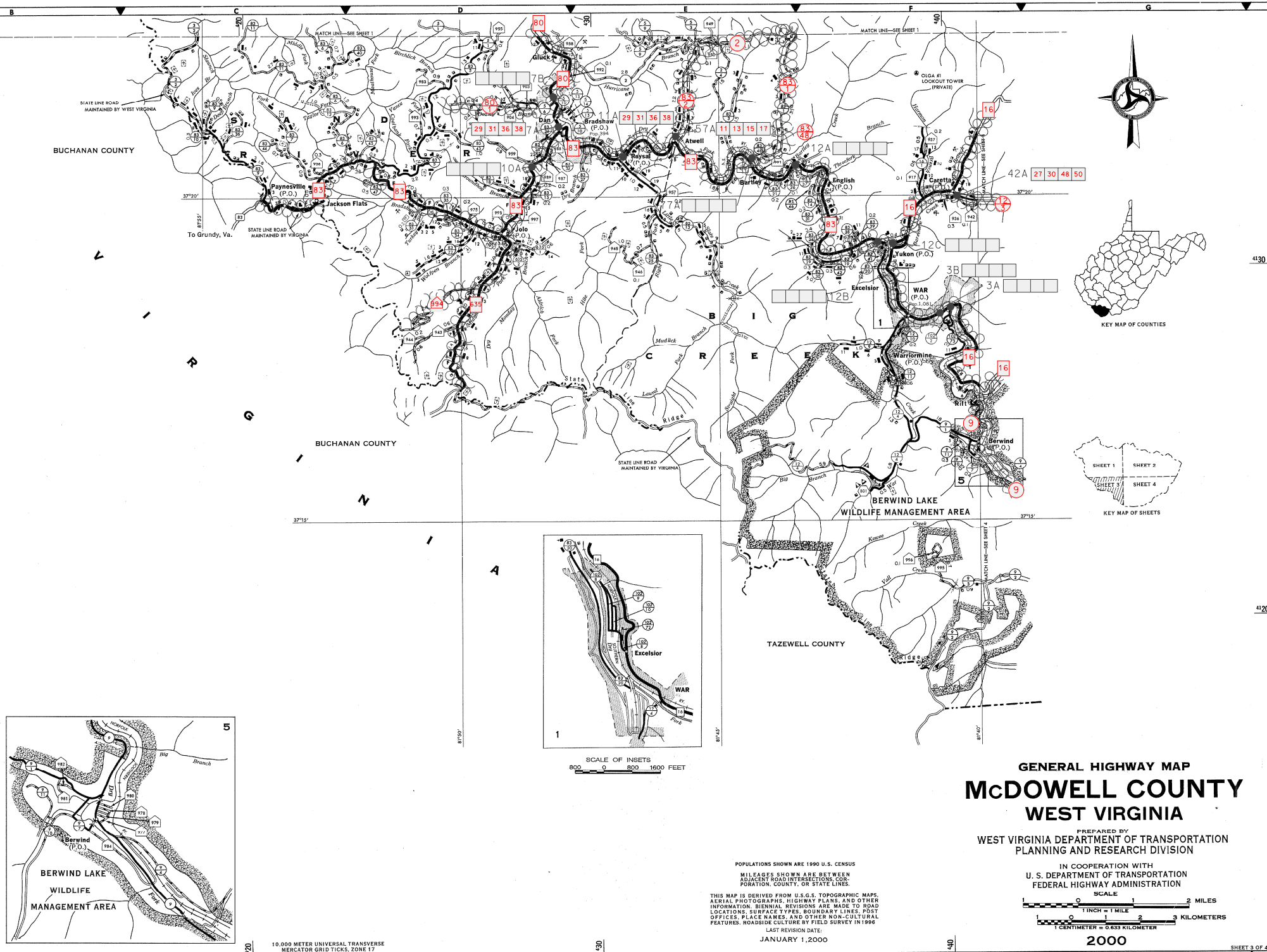
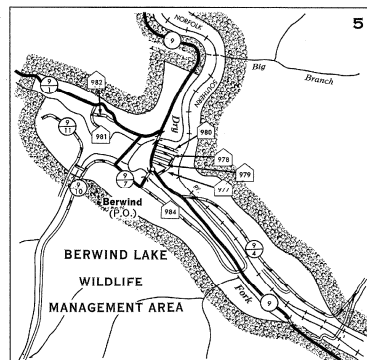
