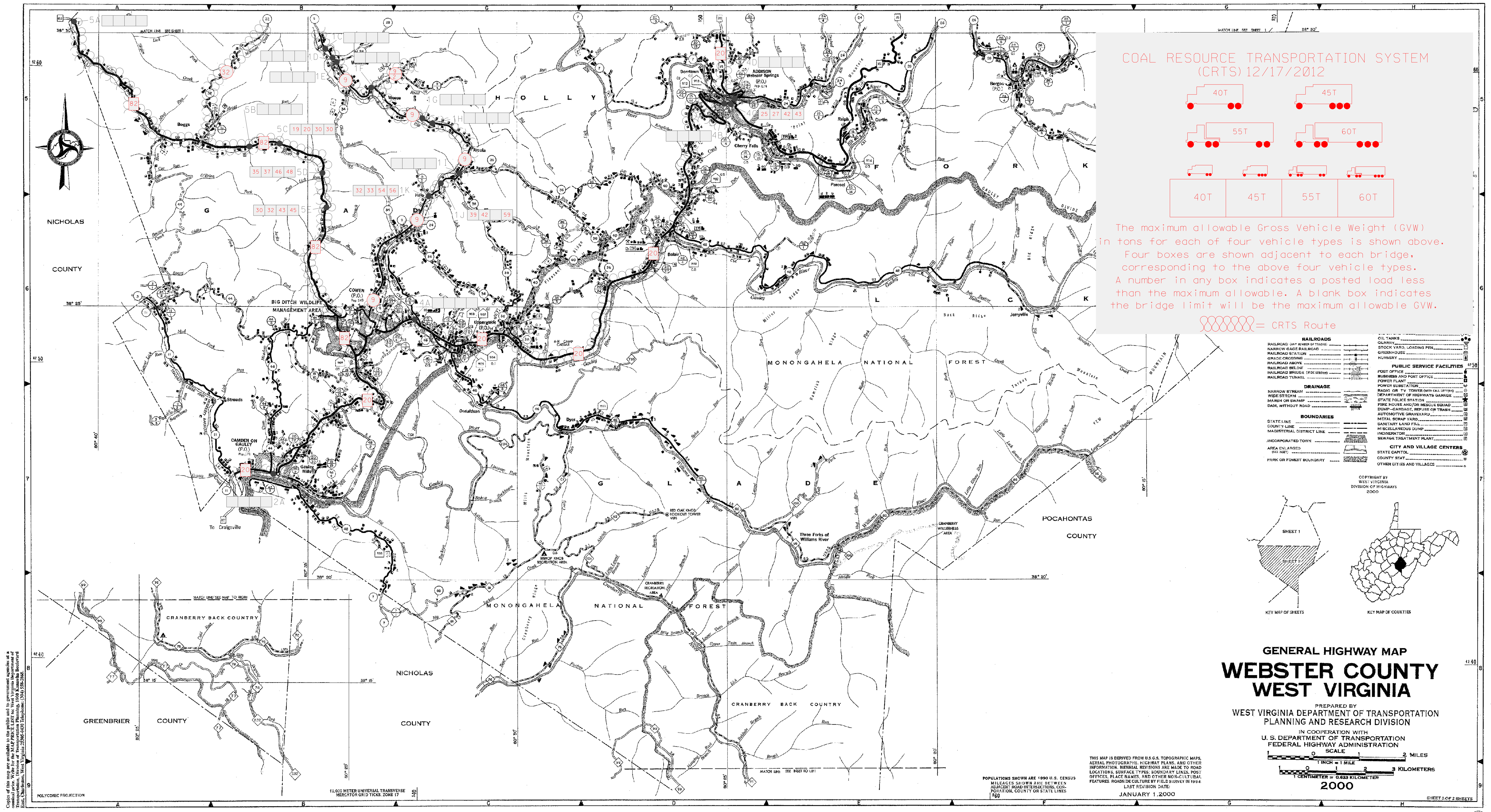
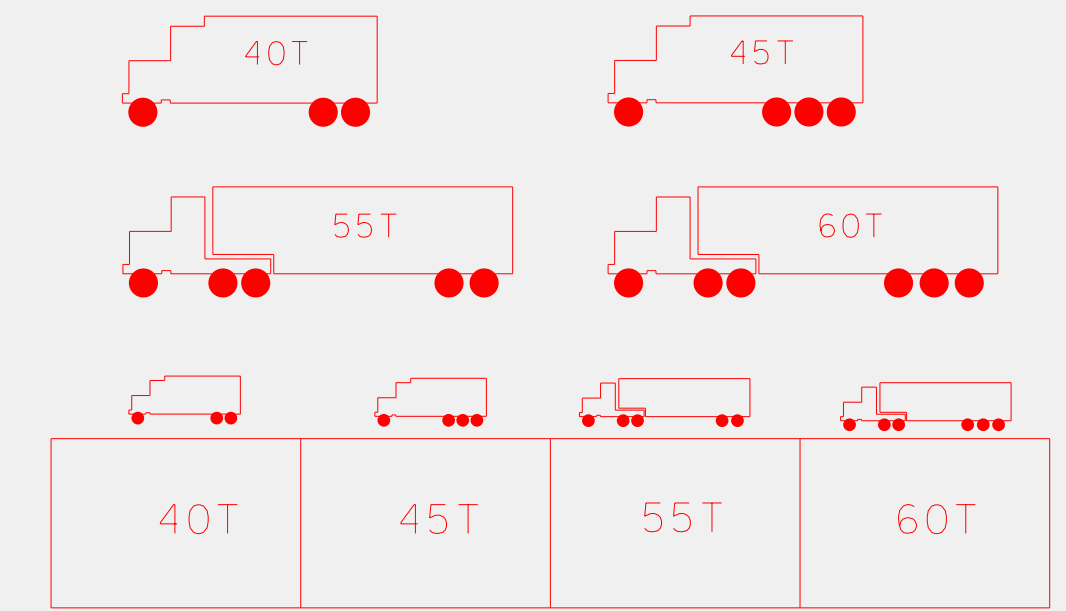




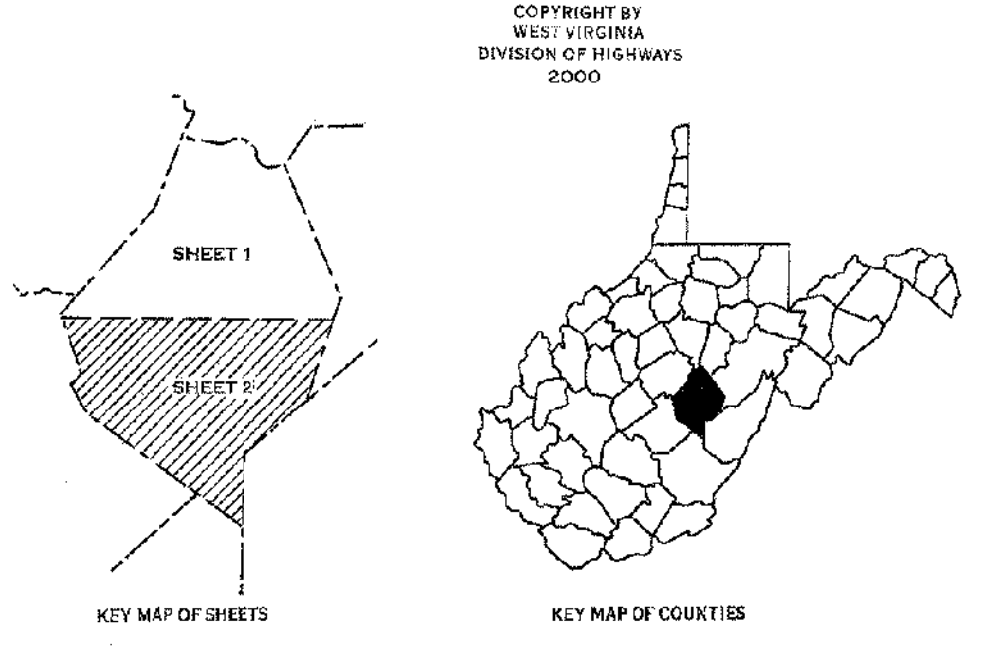
# COAL RESOURCE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (CRTS) 12/17/2012

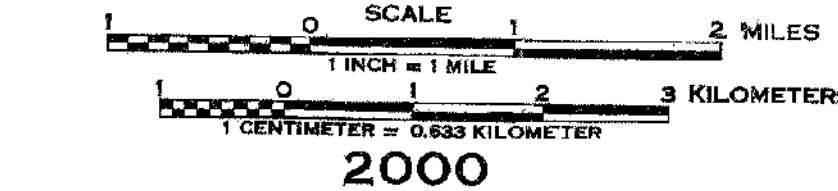
