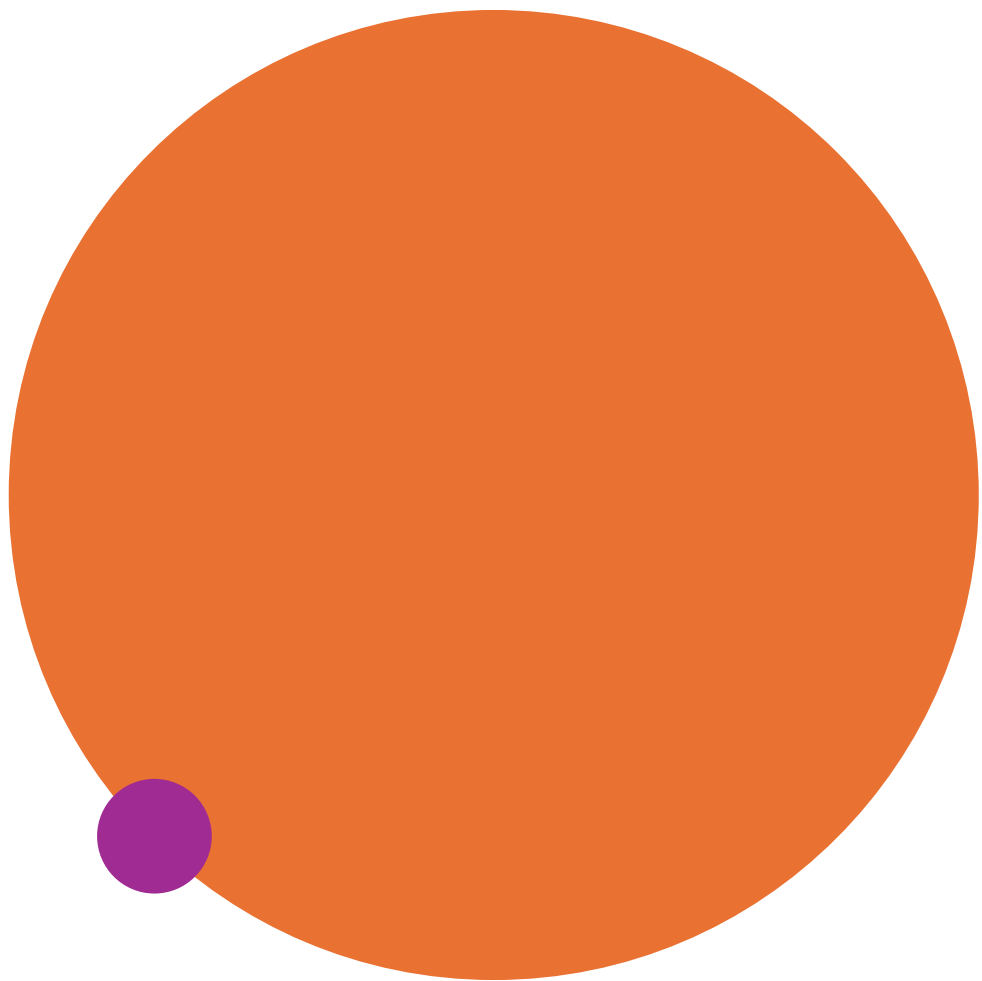
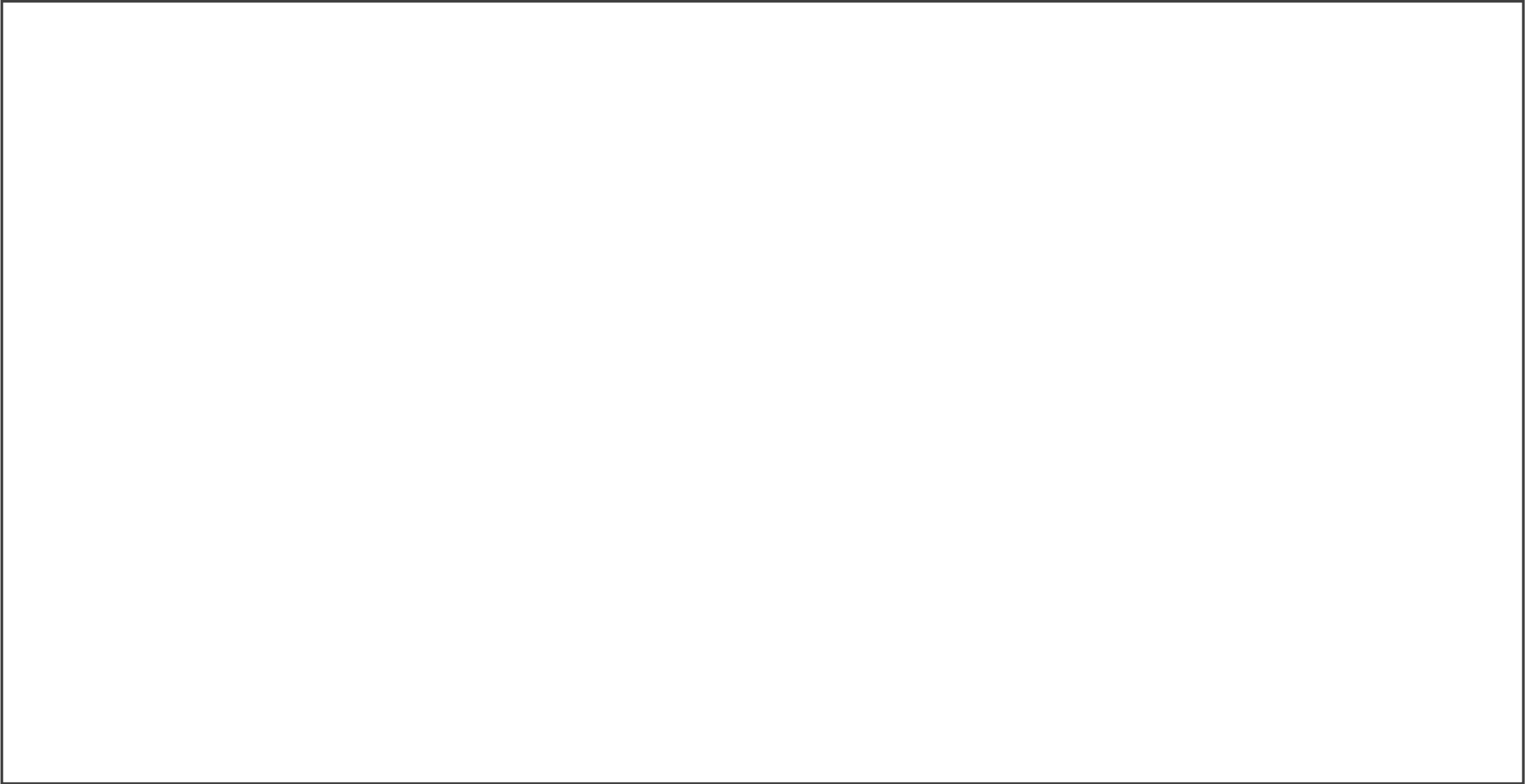




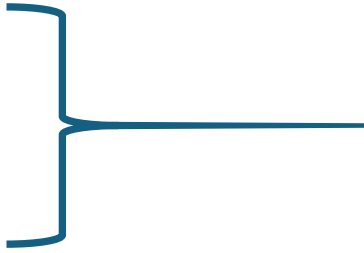








Demo Graph of Results

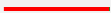

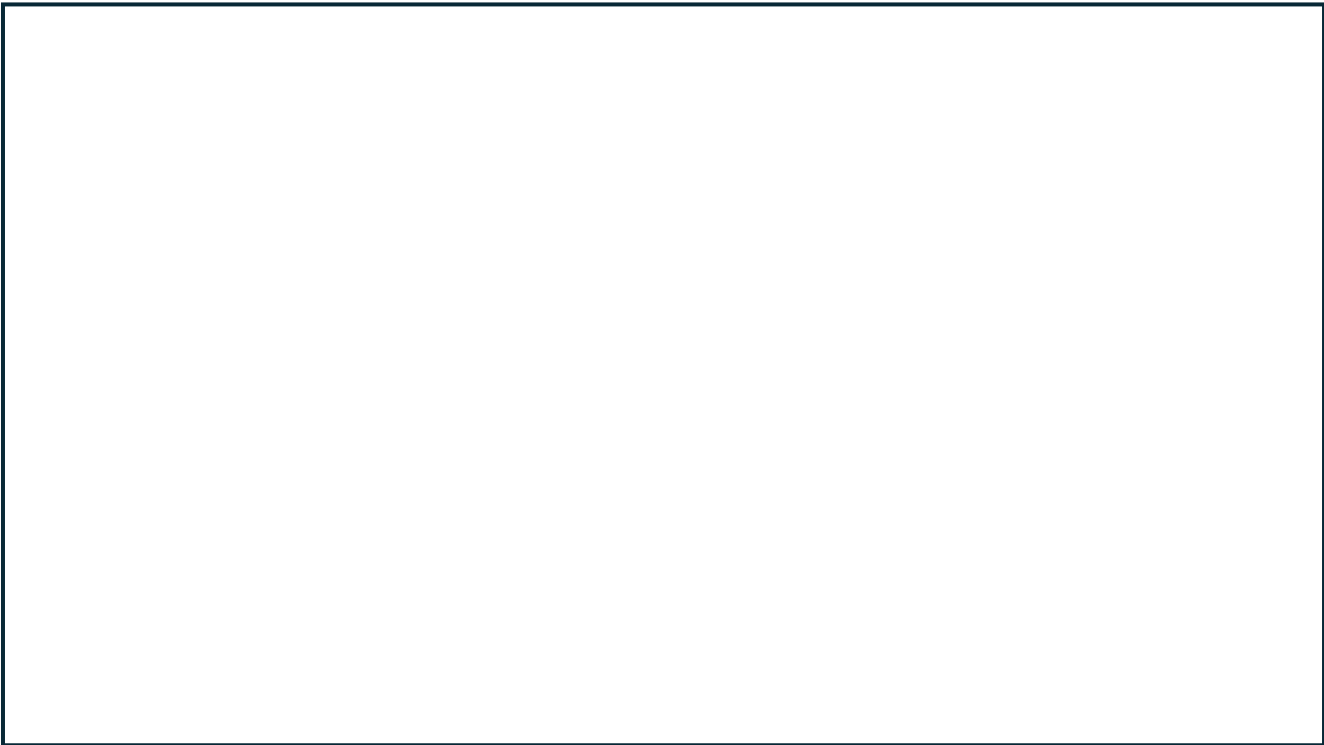
